

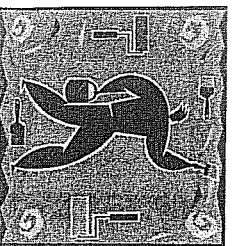
Who, me? Go on a Mission Trip?

What kind of work will we do?

Our work may include clean-up, installing insulation and sheet rock, roofing, painting, clearing land or doing yard work. The team may also assist with clerical and clean-up work in the Volunteer Village.

What is a day like in the life of a volunteer?

Breakfast begins at 7:00 a.m. followed by devotions. Volunteers then leave by 8:30 a.m. for work sites and return by 5:00 p.m. Supper is served at 6:00 p.m., followed by evening devotions and summary of the day's activities and lights out at 10:00 p.m. Teams in the village take turns leading devotions and cooking for the camp.

What are the housing arrangements?

We will be housed in a local church. There are showers, toilets, and full cooking facilities.

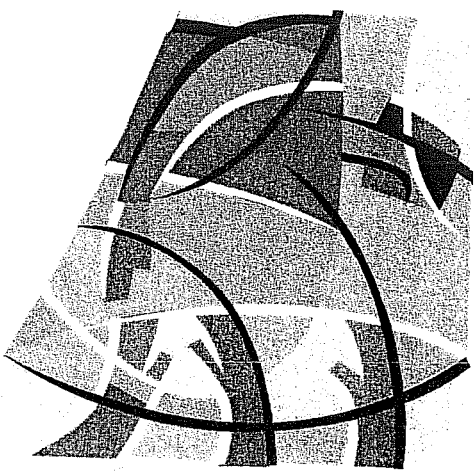
